άδελφοι - brothers - [133x's in Paul, 39x in 1 Corinthians] it is a term of affection and implies personal acquaintance, often used when something painful needs to be said, to indicate that it is bing said out of love. It is interesting that it is not used to refer to either the Ephesians or the Cololssians, although it is used in those letters. It is also a reminder and reference to our adoption as children of God.

τοῦ κυρίου ἡμῶν - [taking gentive plural] 72x in NT, all but 18 are in Paul - 10x in 1Corinthians - the "our" which is always used elsewhere refers, not the a single congregation, but to the whole Christian community. In this connection it is worth noting that "your" is NEVER used! This means that "our" can sometimes carry a further implication, namely, that of mutual inter-relationship of the community itself, which imposses obligations.

αὐτὸ λέγητε πάντες - - agree, literally "say the same" a classical expression, used of political communities which are free from factions or of different states which entertain friendly relations

σχίσματα - 8x in NT - (derivative of σχίζω to split, to tear) the condition resulting from the splitting or tearing - a division into opposing groups, generally two - the dividing line seems to be attachment to individual leaders, who are played off against each other, which is breaking up the common meal, there is no evidence of firmly formulated doctrinal positions & programs being at the root of the division. The fabric being rent is the fabric of community, the issue returns in 1 Cor11:18 with resolution, now it is setting the stage

Matt 9:16 And no one puts a piece of unshrunk cloth on an old garment, for the patch tears away from the garment, and a worse tear is made.

Mark 2:21 No one sews a piece of unshrunk cloth on an old garment; if he does, the patch tears away from it, the new from the old, and a worse tear is made.

νους - mind [24x in NT] - inward man, heart, will, soul, spirit, conscience, - no real english equivalent. Much of its use is inclusive & pregnant, especially with regard to knowing God, or recieving the Divine Revelation.

Gal 6:12 It is those who want to make a good showing in the flesh that would compel you to be circumcised, and only in order that they may not be persecuted for the cross of Christ.

Gal 6:14 But far be it from me to glory except in the cross of our Lord Jesus Christ, by which the world has been crucified to me, and I to the world.

Eph 2:16and might reconcile us both to God in one body through the cross, thereby bringing the hostility to an end.

Phil 2:8 And being found in human form he humbled himself and became obedient unto death, even death on a cross.

Phil 3:18 For many, of whom I have often told you and now tell you even with tears, live as enemies of the cross of Christ.

Col 1:20 and through him to reconcile to himself all things, whether on earth or in heaven, making peace by the blood of his cross.

Col 2:14 having canceled the bond which stood against us with its legal demands; this he set aside, nailing it to the cross. Heb 12:2 looking to Jesus the pioneer and perfecter of our faith, who for the joy that was set before him endured the cross, despising the shame, and is seated at the right hand of the throne of God.
