

## 2 Timothy 1:3-14

1:3 Χάριν ἔχω τῷ θεῷ, ᾧ λατρεύω ἀπὸ προγόνων ἐν καθαρᾷ συνειδήσει, ὡς ἀδιάλειπτον ἔχω τὴν περὶ σοῦ μνείαν ἐν ταῖς δεήσεσίν μου νυκτὸς καὶ ἡμέρας,  
I thank God, whom I serve, as my forefathers did, with a clear conscience, as night and day I constantly remember you in my prayers.

Χάριν . . . τῷ θεῷ, - [noun acc fem sing + ο θεος ] 13x in NT - *grace ... from God*

Luke 1:30 And the angel said to her, "Do not be afraid, Mary, for you have found favor with God.

Acts 7:46 who found favor in the sight of God and asked leave to find a habitation for the God of Jacob.

Acts 11:23 When he came and saw the grace of God, he was glad; and he exhorted them all to remain faithful to the Lord with steadfast purpose;

1Cor 3:10 According to the grace of God given to me, like a skilled master builder I laid a foundation, and another man is building upon it. Let each man take care how he builds upon it.

2Cor 6:1 Working together with him, then, we entreat you not to accept the grace of God in vain.

2Cor 8:1 We want you to know, brethren, about the grace of God which has been shown in the churches of Macedo'nia,

2Cor 9:14 while they long for you and pray for you, because of the surpassing grace of God in you.

Gal 2:21 I do not nullify the grace of God; for if justification were through the law, then Christ died to no purpose.

1Tim 1:12 I thank him who has given me strength for this, Christ Jesus our Lord, because he judged me faithful by appointing me to his service,

λατρεύω - 21x in NT, 4x in Paul - present active indicative 1p sing 4x in NT \* - *to perform religious rites as a part of worship* -

\*Acts 24:14 But this I admit to you, that according to the Way, which they call a sect, I worship the God of our fathers, believing everything laid down by the law or written in the prophets,

\*Acts 27:23 For this very night there stood by me an angel of the God to whom I belong and whom I worship,

\*Romans 1:9 For God is my witness, whom I serve with my spirit in the gospel of his Son, that without ceasing I mention you always in my prayers,

\*2Tim 1:3 I thank God whom I serve with a clear conscience, as did my fathers, when I remember you constantly in my prayers.

Romans 1:25 because they exchanged the truth about God for a lie and worshiped and served the creature rather than the Creator, who is blessed for ever! Amen.

προγόνων - 2x in NT - *a person several preceding generations removed from the reference person* -

1Tim 5:4 If a widow has children or grandchildren, let them first learn their religious duty to their own family and make some return to their parents; for this is acceptable in the sight of God.

2Tim 1:3 I thank God whom I serve with a clear conscience, as did my fathers, when I remember you constantly in my prayers.

ἐν καθαρᾷ συνειδήσει - 2x in NT -

1Tim 3:9 they must hold the mystery of the faith with a clear conscience.

2Tim 1:3 I thank God whom I serve with a clear conscience, as did my fathers, when I remember you constantly in my prayers.

καθαρᾷ - 27x in NT - *pertaining to not being dirty -pertaining to being ritually clean or pure* -

Matt 5:8 "Blessed are the pure in heart, for they shall see God.

Matt 23:26 You blind Pharisee! first cleanse the inside of the cup and of the plate, that the outside also may be clean.

Matt 27:59 And Joseph took the body, and wrapped it in a clean linen shroud,  
 Luke 11:41 But give for alms those things which are within; and behold, everything is clean for you.  
 John 13:10 Jesus said to him, "He who has bathed does not need to wash, except for his feet, but he is clean all over; and you are clean, but not every one of you."

### *συνειδήσει - 30x in NT - to be aware of information about something - the psychological faculty which can distinguish between right and wrong -*

Acts 23:1 And Paul, looking intently at the council, said, "Brethren, I have lived before God in all good conscience up to this day."  
 Acts 24:16 So I always take pains to have a clear conscience toward God and toward men.  
 Romans 2:15 They show that what the law requires is written on their hearts, while their conscience also bears witness and their conflicting thoughts accuse or perhaps excuse them  
 Romans 9:1 I am speaking the truth in Christ, I am not lying; my conscience bears me witness in the Holy Spirit,  
 Romans 13:5 Therefore one must be subject, not only to avoid God's wrath but also for the sake of conscience.  
 1Cor 8:7 However, not all possess this knowledge. But some, through being hitherto accustomed to idols, eat food as really offered to an idol; and their conscience, being weak, is defiled.  
 1Cor 8:10 For if any one sees you, a man of knowledge, at table in an idol's temple, might he not be encouraged, if his conscience is weak, to eat food offered to idols?  
 1Cor 8:12 Thus, sinning against your brethren and wounding their conscience when it is weak, you sin against Christ.  
 1Cor 10:25 Eat whatever is sold in the meat market without raising any question on the ground of conscience.  
 1Cor 10:27 If one of the unbelievers invites you to dinner and you are disposed to go, eat whatever is set before you without raising any question on the ground of conscience.  
 1Cor 10:28 (But if some one says to you, "This has been offered in sacrifice," then out of consideration for the man who informed you, and for conscience' sake --  
 1Cor 10:29 I mean his conscience, not yours -- do not eat it.) For why should my liberty be determined by another man's scruples?  
 1Cor 10:29 I mean his conscience, not yours -- do not eat it.) For why should my liberty be determined by another man's scruples?  
 2Cor 1:12 For our boast is this, the testimony of our conscience that we have behaved in the world, and still more toward you, with holiness and godly sincerity, not by earthly wisdom but by the grace of God.  
 2Cor 4:2 We have renounced disgraceful, underhanded ways; we refuse to practice cunning or to tamper with God's word, but by the open statement of the truth we would commend ourselves to every man's conscience in the sight of God.  
 2Cor 5:11 Therefore, knowing the fear of the Lord, we persuade men; but what we are is known to God, and I hope it is known also to your conscience.

1Tim 1:5 whereas the aim of our charge is love that issues from a pure heart and a good conscience and sincere faith.  
 1Tim 1:19 holding faith and a good conscience. By rejecting conscience, certain persons have made shipwreck of their faith,  
 1Tim 3:9 they must hold the mystery of the faith with a clear conscience.  
 1Tim 4:2 through the pretensions of liars whose consciences are seared,  
 2Tim 1:3 I thank God whom I serve with a clear conscience, as did my fathers, when I remember you constantly in my prayers.  
 Titus 1:15 To the pure all things are pure, but to the corrupt and unbelieving nothing is pure; their very minds and consciences are corrupted.  
 Heb 9:9 (which is symbolic for the present age). According to this arrangement, gifts and sacrifices are offered which cannot perfect the conscience of the worshiper,  
 Heb 9:14 how much more shall the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered himself without blemish to God, purify your conscience from dead works to serve the living God.  
 Heb 10:2 Otherwise, would they not have ceased to be offered? If the worshipers had once been cleansed, they would no longer have any consciousness of sin.  
 Heb 10:22 let us draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith, with our hearts sprinkled clean from an evil conscience and our bodies washed with pure water.  
 Heb 13:18 Pray for us, for we are sure that we have a clear conscience, desiring to act honorably in all things.  
 1Peter 2:19 For one is approved if, mindful of God, he endures pain while suffering unjustly.  
 1Peter 3:16 and keep your conscience clear, so that, when you are abused, those who revile your good behavior in Christ may be put to shame.  
 1Peter 3:21 Baptism, which corresponds to this, now saves you, not as a removal of dirt from the body but as an appeal to God for a clear conscience, through the resurrection of Jesus Christ,

### ἀδιάλειπτον - 2x in NT - *pertaining to not ceasing from some continuous activity* -

Romans 9:2 that I have great sorrow and unceasing anguish in my heart.  
 2Tim 1:3 I thank God whom I serve with a clear conscience, as did my fathers, when I remember you constantly in my prayers.

### περὶ σοῦ - 26x in NT, 12x in Paul, - *concerning you*

Romans 15:14 I myself am satisfied about you, my brethren, that you yourselves are full of goodness, filled with all knowledge, and able to instruct one another.  
 1Cor 1:4 I give thanks to God always for you because of the grace of God which was given you in Christ Jesus,  
 1Cor 1:11 For it has been reported to me by Chlo'e's people that there is quarreling among you, my brethren.  
 Phil 1:27 Only let your manner of life be worthy of the gospel of Christ, so that whether I come and see you or am absent, I may hear of you that you stand firm in one spirit, with one mind striving side by side for the faith of the gospel,  
 Phil 2:19 I hope in the Lord Jesus to send Timothy to you soon, so that I may be cheered by news of you.  
 Phil 2:20 I have no one like him, who will be genuinely anxious for your welfare.  
 Col 1:3 We always thank God, the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, when we pray for you,  
 1Thess 3:9 For what thanksgiving can we render to God for you, for all the joy which we feel for your sake before our God,  
 2Thess 1:3 We are bound to give thanks to God always for you, brethren, as is fitting, because your faith is growing abundantly, and the love of every one of you for one another is increasing.  
 2Thess 1:11 To this end we always pray for you, that our God may make you worthy of his call, and may fulfil every good resolve and work of faith by his power,  
 2Thess 2:13 But we are bound to give thanks to God always for you, brethren beloved by the Lord, because God chose you from the beginning to be saved, through sanctification by the Spirit and belief in the truth.  
 2Tim 1:3 I thank God whom I serve with a clear conscience, as did my fathers, when I remember you constantly in my prayers.

### μνείαν - 7x in NT - *to recall information from memory, but without necessarily the implication that persons have actually forgotten - to recall and to respond by making mention of* -

Romans 1:9 For God is my witness, whom I serve with my spirit in the gospel of his Son, that without ceasing I mention you always in my prayers,  
 Eph 1:16 I do not cease to give thanks for you, remembering you in my prayers,  
 Phil 1:3 I thank my God in all my remembrance of you,  
 1Thess 1:2 We give thanks to God always for you all, constantly mentioning you in our prayers,  
 1Thess 3:6 But now that Timothy has come to us from you, and has brought us the good news of your faith and love and reported that you always remember us kindly and long to see us, as we long to see you --  
 2Tim 1:3 I thank God whom I serve with a clear conscience, as did my fathers, when I remember you constantly in my prayers.  
 Philem 1:4 I thank my God always when I remember you in my prayers,

### ἐν ταῖς δεήσεσίν - NT Hapax

δεήσεσίν - 18x in NT - *(derivative of δέομαι to plead, to beg) that which is asked with urgency based on presumed need* -

Luke 1:13 But the angel said to him, "Do not be afraid, Zechari'ah, for your prayer is heard, and your wife Elizabeth will bear you a son, and you shall call his name John.

Luke 2:37 and as a widow till she was eighty-four. She did not depart from the temple, worshiping with fasting and prayer night and day.

Luke 5:33 And they said to him, "The disciples of John fast often and offer prayers, and so do the disciples of the Pharisees, but yours eat and drink."

Romans 10:1 Brethren, my heart's desire and prayer to God for them is that they may be saved.

2Cor 1:11 You also must help us by prayer, so that many will give thanks on our behalf for the blessing granted us in answer to many prayers.

2Cor 9:14 while they long for you and pray for you, because of the surpassing grace of God in you.

Eph 6:18 [2x] Pray at all times in the Spirit, with all prayer and supplication. To that end keep alert with all perseverance, making supplication for all the saints,

Phil 1:4 [2x] always in every prayer of mine for you all making my prayer with joy,

Phil 1:19 Yes, and I shall rejoice. For I know that through your prayers and the help of the Spirit of Jesus Christ this will turn out for my deliverance,

Phil 4:6 Have no anxiety about anything, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God.

1Tim 2:1 First of all, then, I urge that supplications, prayers, intercessions, and thanksgivings be made for all men,

1Tim 5:5 She who is a real widow, and is left all alone, has set her hope on God and continues in supplications and prayers night and day;

2Tim 1:3 I thank God whom I serve with a clear conscience, as did my fathers, when I remember you constantly in my prayers.

Mark 4:27 and should sleep and rise night and day, and the seed should sprout and grow, he knows not how.

Mark 5:5 Night and day among the tombs and on the mountains he was always crying out, and bruising himself with stones.

Luke 2:37 and as a widow till she was eighty-four. She did not depart from the temple, worshiping with fasting and prayer night and day.

Acts 20:31 Therefore be alert, remembering that for three years I did not cease night or day to admonish every one with tears.

Acts 26:7 to which our twelve tribes hope to attain, as they earnestly worship night and day. And for this hope I am accused by Jews, O king!

1Thess 2:9 For you remember our labor and toil, brethren; we worked night and day, that we might not burden any of you, while we preached to you the gospel of God.

1Thess 3:10 praying earnestly night and day that we may see you face to face and supply what is lacking in your faith?

2Thess 3:8 we did not eat any one's bread without paying, but with toil and labor we worked night and day, that we might not burden any of you.

1Tim 5:5 She who is a real widow, and is left all alone, has set her hope on God and continues in supplications and prayers night and day;

2Tim 1:3 I thank God whom I serve with a clear conscience, as did my fathers, when I remember you constantly in my prayers.

1:4 ἐπιποθῶν σε ἰδεῖν, μεμνημένος σου τῶν δακρύων, ἵνα χαρᾶς πληρωθῶ,  
Recalling your tears, I long to see you, so that I may be filled with joy.

### ἐπιποθῶν - 9x in NT - *to long for something, with the implication of recognizing a lack -to experience a yearning affection for someone* -

Romans 1:11 For I long to see you, that I may impart to you some spiritual gift to strengthen you,

2Cor 5:2 Here indeed we groan, and long to put on our heavenly dwelling,

2Cor 9:14 while they long for you and pray for you, because of the surpassing grace of God in you.

Phil 1:8 For God is my witness, how I yearn for you all with the affection of Christ Jesus.

Phil 2:26 for he has been longing for you all, and has been distressed because you heard that he was ill.

1Thess 3:6 But now that Timothy has come to us from you, and has brought us the good news of your faith and love and reported that you always remember us kindly and long to see us, as we long to see you --

2Tim 1:4 As I remember your tears, I long night and day to see you, that I may be filled with joy.

James 4:5 Or do you suppose it is in vain that the scripture says, "He yearns jealously over the spirit which he has made to dwell in us"?

1Peter 2:2 Like newborn babes, long for the pure spiritual milk, that by it you may grow up to salvation;

ἰδεῖν - 341x in NT - aorist active infinitive 38x in NT, 7x in Paul - *see*

Romans 1:11 For I long to see you, that I may impart to you some spiritual gift to strengthen you,

1Cor 16:7 For I do not want to see you now just in passing; I hope to spend some time with you, if the Lord permits.

1Thess 2:17 But since we were bereft of you, brethren, for a short time, in person not in heart, we endeavored the more eagerly and with great desire to see you face to face;

1Thess 3:6 But now that Timothy has come to us from you, and has brought us the good news of your faith and love and reported that you always remember us kindly and long to see us, as we long to see you --

1Thess 3:10 praying earnestly night and day that we may see you face to face and supply what is lacking in your faith?

1Tim 6:16 who alone has immortality and dwells in unapproachable light, whom no man has ever seen or can see. To him be honor and eternal dominion. Amen.

2Tim 1:4 As I remember your tears, I long night and day to see you, that I may be filled with joy.

μνηστικός - 2x in NT - *to recall or be aware of information, and as a result to respond in an appropriate manner (for example, punishing, helping, honoring, etc., depending upon the context)* -

1Cor 11:2 I commend you because you remember me in everything and maintain the traditions even as I have delivered them to you.

2Tim 1:4 As I remember your tears, I long night and day to see you, that I may be filled with joy.

δακρύων - 10x in NT - *to weep, with the clear implication of shedding tears* -

Luke 7:38 and standing behind him at his feet, weeping, she began to wet his feet with her tears, and wiped them with the hair of her head, and kissed his feet, and anointed them with the ointment.

Luke 7:44 Then turning toward the woman he said to Simon, "Do you see this woman? I entered your house, you gave me no water for my feet, but she has wet my feet with her tears and wiped them with her hair.

Acts 20:19 serving the Lord with all humility and with tears and with trials which befell me through the plots of the Jews;

Acts 20:31 Therefore be alert, remembering that for three years I did not cease night or day to admonish every one with tears.

2Cor 2:4 For I wrote you out of much affliction and anguish of heart and with many tears, not to cause you pain but to let you know the abundant love that I have for you.

2Tim 1:4 As I remember your tears, I long night and day to see you, that I may be filled with joy.

Heb 5:7 In the days of his flesh, Jesus offered up prayers and supplications, with loud cries and tears, to him who was able to save him from death, and he was heard for his godly fear.

Heb 12:17 For you know that afterward, when he desired to inherit the blessing, he was rejected, for he found no chance to repent, though he sought it with tears.

Rev 7:17 For the Lamb in the midst of the throne will be their shepherd, and he will guide them to springs of living water; and God will wipe away every tear from their eyes."

ἵνα χαρᾶς πληρωθῶ - NT Hapax

χαρᾶς - 59x in NT, 21x in Paul - *a state of joy and gladness - that which is the cause of joy or gladness*

Romans 14:17 For the kingdom of God is not food and drink but righteousness and peace and joy in the Holy Spirit;

Romans 15:13 May the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace in believing, so that by the power of the Holy Spirit you may abound in hope.

Romans 15:32 so that by God's will I may come to you with joy and be refreshed in your company.

2Cor 1:24 Not that we lord it over your faith; we work with you for your joy, for you stand firm in your faith.

2Cor 2:3 And I wrote as I did, so that when I came I might not suffer pain from those who should have made me rejoice, for I felt sure of all of you, that my joy would be the joy of you all.

2Cor 7:4 I have great confidence in you; I have great pride in you; I am filled with comfort. With all our affliction, I am overjoyed.

2Cor 7:13 Therefore we are comforted. And besides our own comfort we rejoiced still more at the joy of Titus, because his mind has been set at rest by you all.

2Cor 8:2 for in a severe test of affliction, their abundance of joy and their extreme poverty have overflowed in a wealth of liberality on their part.

Gal 5:22 But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness,

Phil 1:4 always in every prayer of mine for you all making my prayer with joy,

Phil 1:25 Convinced of this, I know that I shall remain and continue with you all, for your progress and joy in the faith,

Phil 2:2 complete my joy by being of the same mind, having the same love, being in full accord and of one mind.

Phil 2:29 So receive him in the Lord with all joy; and honor such men,

Phil 4:1 Therefore, my brethren, whom I love and long for, my joy and crown, stand firm thus in the Lord, my beloved.

Col 1:11 May you be strengthened with all power, according to his glorious might, for all endurance and patience with joy,

1Thess 1:6 And you became imitators of us and of the Lord, for you received the word in much affliction, with joy inspired by the Holy Spirit;

1Thess 2:19 For what is our hope or joy or crown of boasting before our Lord Jesus at his coming? Is it not you?

1Thess 2:20 For you are our glory and joy.

1Thess 3:9 For what thanksgiving can we render to God for you, for all the joy which we feel for your sake before our God,

2Tim 1:4 As I remember your tears, I long night and day to see you, that I may be filled with joy.

Romans 1:29 They were filled with all manner of wickedness, evil, covetousness, malice. Full of envy, murder, strife, deceit, malignity, they are gossips,

\*Romans 8:4 in order that the just requirement of the law might be fulfilled in us, who walk not according to the flesh but according to the Spirit.

Romans 13:8 Owe no one anything, except to love one another; for he who loves his neighbor has fulfilled the law.

Romans 15:13 May the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace in believing, so that by the power of the Holy Spirit you may abound in hope.

Romans 15:14 I myself am satisfied about you, my brethren, that you yourselves are full of goodness, filled with all knowledge, and able to instruct one another.

Prov 19:15 δειλία κατέχει ἀνδρογύναιον Slothfulness casts into a deep sleep, and an idle person will suffer hunger.

1Mac 4:32 δὸς αὐτοῖς δειλίαν Fill them with cowardice; melt the boldness of their strength; let them tremble in their destruction.

2Mac 3:24 But when he arrived at the treasury with his bodyguard, then and there the Sovereign of spirits and of all authority caused so great a manifestation that all who had been so bold as to accompany him were astounded by the power of God, εἰς ἔκλυσιν καὶ δειλίαν τραπήναι and became faint with terror.

Acts 26:25 But Paul said, "I am not mad, most excellent Festus, but I am speaking the sober truth.

1Tim 2:9 also that women should adorn themselves modestly and sensibly in seemly apparel, not with braided hair or gold or pearls or costly attire

1Tim 2:15 Yet woman will be saved through bearing children, if she continues in faith and love and holiness, with modesty.

**σωφρονέω** - verb 6x in NT -

Mark 5:15 And they came to Jesus, and saw the demoniac sitting there, clothed and in his right mind, the man who had had the legion; and they were afraid.

Luke 8:35 Then people went out to see what had happened, and they came to Jesus, and found the man from whom the demons had gone, sitting at the feet of Jesus, clothed and in his right mind; and they were afraid.

Romans 12:3 For by the grace given to me I bid every one among you not to think of himself more highly than he ought to think, but to think with sober judgment, each according to the measure of faith which God has assigned him.
