1 In the year that King Uzziah died, I saw the Lord seated on a throne, high and exalted, and the train of his robe filled the temple.

Gen 18:21 I must go down and see whether they have done altogether according to the outcry that has come to me; and if not, I will know."

Ezek 2:9 I looked, and a hand was stretched out to me, and a written scroll was in it.

Ezek 8:2 I looked, and there was a figure that looked like a human being; below what appeared to be its loins it was fire, and above the loins it was like the appearance of brightness, like gleaming amber.

Ezek 8:7 And he brought me to the entrance of the court; I looked, and there was a hole in the wall.

Ezek 8:10 So I went in and looked; there, portrayed on the wall all around, were all kinds of creeping things, and loathsome animals, and all the idols of the house of Israel.

Ezek 10:1 Then I looked, and above the dome that was over the heads of the cherubim there appeared above them something like a sapphire, in form resembling a throne.

Ezek 10:9 I looked, and there were four wheels beside the cherubim, one beside each cherub; and the appearance of the wheels was like gleaming beryl.

Ezek 11:1 The spirit lifted me up and brought me to the east gate of the house of the LORD, which faces east. There, at the entrance of the gateway, were twenty-five men; among them I saw Jaazaniah son of Azzur, and Pelatiah son of Benaiah, officials of the people.

Ezek 16:6 I passed by you, and saw you flailing about in your blood. As you lay in your blood, I said to you, "Live!

Ezek 16:8 I passed by you again and looked on you; you were at the age for love. I spread the edge of my cloak over you, and covered your nakedness: I pledged myself to you and entered into a covenant with you, says the Lord GOD, and you became mine.

Ezek 23:13 And I saw that she was defiled; they both took the same way.

Ezek 44:4 Then he brought me by way of the north gate to the front of the temple; and I looked, and lo! the glory of the LORD

filled the temple of the LORD; and I fell upon my face.

Micah 7:9 must bear the indignation of the LORD, because I have sinned against him, until he takes my side and executes judgment for me. He will bring me out to the light; I shall see his vindication.

Zech 2:1 I looked up and saw a man with a measuring line in his hand.

Qoh 4:1 Again I saw all the oppressions that are practiced under the sun. And behold, the tears of the oppressed, and they had no one to comfort them! On the side of their oppressors there was power, and there was no one to comfort them.

Qoh 4:7 Again, I saw vanity under the sun:

Dan 8:2 [2x] In the vision I was looking and saw myself in Susa the capital, in the province of Elam, and I was by the river Ulai.

Dan 8:3 I looked up and saw a ram standing beside the river. It had two horns. Both horns were long, but one was longer than the other, and the longer one came up second.

Dan 10:5 I looked up and saw a man clothed in linen, with a belt of gold from Uphaz around his waist.

Dan 10:8 So I was left alone to see this great vision. My strength left me, and my complexion grew deathly pale, and I retained no strength.

Psalms 11:4 The LORD is in his holy temple; the Lord's throne is in heaven. His eyes behold, his gaze examines humankind.

Psalms 45:7 [6E] Your throne, O God, endures forever and ever. Your royal scepter is a scepter of equity; 45:7 you love righteousness and hate wickedness. Therefore God,

Psalms 47:9 [8E] God is king over the nations; God sits on his holy throne. 47:9 The princes of the peoples gather as the people of the God

Psalms 89:5 [4E] 'I will establish your descendants forever, and build your throne for all generations.'"

Psalms 89:15 [14E] Righteousness and justice are the foundation of your throne; steadfast love and faithfulness go before you.

89:15 Happy are the people who know the festal shout, who walk,

Psalms 89:30 [29E] I will establish his line forever, and his throne as long as the heavens endure.

Psalms 89:37 It shall be established forever like the moon, an enduring witness in the skies."

Psalms 93:2 your throne is established from of old; you are from everlasting.

Psalms 97:2 Clouds and thick darkness are all around him; righteousness and justice are the foundation of his throne.

Psalms 103:19 The LORD has established his throne in the heavens, and his kingdom rules over all.

Isaiah 30:12 Therefore thus says the Holy One of Israel: Because you reject this word, and put your trust in oppression and deceit, and rely on them;

Isaiah 30:15 For thus said the Lord GOD, the Holy One of Israel: In returning and rest you shall be saved; in quietness and in trust shall be your strength. But you refused

Isaiah 31:1 Alas for those who go down to Egypt for help and who rely on horses, who trust in chariots because they are many and in horsemen because they are very strong, but do not look to the Holy One of Israel or consult the LORD!

Isaiah 37:23 Whom have you mocked and reviled? Against whom have you raised your voice and haughtily lifted your eyes? Against the Holy One of Israel!

Isaiah 40:25 To whom then will you compare me, or who is my equal? says the Holy One.

Isaiah 41:14 Do not fear, you worm Jacob, you insect Israel! I will help you, says the LORD; your Redeemer is the Holy One of Israel.

Isaiah 41:16 You shall winnow them and the wind shall carry them away, and the tempest shall scatter them. Then you shall rejoice in the LORD; in the Holy One of Israel you shall glory.

Isaiah 41:20 so that all may see and know, all may consider and understand, that the hand of the LORD has done this, the Holy One of Israel has created it.

Isaiah 43:3 For I am the LORD your God, the Holy One of Israel, your Savior. I give Egypt as your ransom, Ethiopia and Seba in exchange for you.

Isaiah 43:14 Thus says the LORD, your Redeemer, the Holy One of Israel: For your sake I will send to Babylon and break down all the bars, and the shouting of the Chaldeans will be turned to lamentation.

Isaiah 43:15 I am the LORD, your Holy One, the Creator of Israel, your King.

Isaiah 45:11 Thus says the LORD, the Holy One of Israel, and its Maker: Will you question me about my children, or command me concerning the work of my hands?

Isaiah 47:4 Our Redeemer--the LORD of hosts is his name-- is the Holy One of Israel.

Isaiah 48:17 Thus says the LORD, your Redeemer, the Holy One of Israel: I am the LORD your God, who teaches you for your own good, who leads you in the way you should go.

Isaiah 49:7 Thus says the LORD, the Redeemer of Israel and his Holy One, to one deeply despised, abhorred by the nations, the slave of rulers, "Kings shall see and stand up, princes, and they shall prostrate themselves, because of the LORD, who is faithful, the Holy One of Israel, who has chosen you."

Isaiah 57:15 [2x] For thus says the high and lofty one who inhabits eternity, whose name is Holy: I dwell in the high and holy place, and also with those who are contrite and humble in spirit, to revive the spirit of the humble, and to revive the heart of the contrite.

Isaiah 58:13 If you refrain from trampling the sabbath, from pursuing your own interests on my holy day; if you call the sabbath a delight and the holy day of the LORD honorable; if you honor it, not going your own ways, serving your own interests, or pursuing your own affairs;

Isaiah 60:9 For the coastlands shall wait for me, the ships of Tarshish first, to bring your children from far away, their silver and gold with them, for the name of the LORD your God, and for the Holy One of Israel, because he has glorified you.

Isaiah 60:14 The descendants of those who oppressed you shall come bending low to you, and all who despised you shall bow down at your feet; they shall call you the City of the LORD, the Zion of the Holy One of Israel.

1:9 If the LORD of hosts had not left us a few survivors, we would have been like Sodom, and become like Gomorrah.

1:24 Therefore says the Sovereign, the LORD of hosts, the Mighty One of Israel: Ah, I will pour out my wrath on my enemies, and avenge myself on my foes!

2:12 For the LORD of hosts has a day against all that is proud and lofty, against all that is lifted up and high;

3:1 For now the Sovereign, the LORD of hosts, is taking away from Jerusalem and from Judah support and staff-- all support of bread, and all support of water--

3:15 What do you mean by crushing my people, by grinding the face of the poor? says the Lord GOD of hosts.

5:7 For the vineyard of the LORD of hosts is the house of Israel, and the people of Judah are his pleasant planting; he expected justice, but saw bloodshed; righteousness, but heard a cry!

5:9 The LORD of hosts has sworn in my hearing: Surely many houses shall be desolate, large and beautiful houses, without inhabitant.

5:16 But the LORD of hosts is exalted by justice, and the Holy God shows himself holy by righteousness.

5:24 Therefore, as the tongue of fire devours the stubble, and as dry grass sinks down in the flame, so their root will become rotten, and their blossom go up like dust; for they have rejected the instruction of the LORD of hosts, and have despised the word of the Holy One of Israel.

6:3 And one called to another and said: "Holy, holy, holy is the LORD of hosts; the whole earth is full of his glory."

6:5 And I said: "Woe is me! I am lost, for I am a man of unclean lips, and I live among a people of unclean lips; yet my eyes have seen the King, the LORD of hosts!"

8:13 But the LORD of hosts, him you shall regard as holy; let him be your fear, and let him be your dread.

8:18 See, I and the children whom the LORD has given me are signs and portents in Israel from the LORD of hosts, who dwells on Mount Zion.

9:6 For a child has been born for us, a son given to us; authority rests upon his shoulders; and he is named Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace.

9:12 the Arameans on the east and the Philistines on the west, and they devoured Israel with open mouth. For all this his anger has not turned away; his hand is stretched out still.

9:18 For wickedness burned like a fire, consuming briars and thorns; it kindled the thickets of the forest, and they swirled upward in a column of smoke.

10:16 Therefore the Sovereign, the LORD of hosts, will send wasting sickness among his stout warriors, and under his glory a burning will be kindled, like the burning of fire.

10:23 For the Lord GOD of hosts will make a full end, as decreed, in all the earth.

10:24 Therefore thus says the Lord GOD of hosts: O my people, who live in Zion, do not be afraid of the Assyrians when they beat you with a rod and lift up their staff against you as the Egyptians did.

10:26 The LORD of hosts will wield a whip against them, as when he struck Midian at the rock of Oreb; his staff will be over the sea, and he will lift it as he did in Egypt.

10:33 Look, the Sovereign, the LORD of hosts, will lop the boughs with terrifying power; the tallest trees will be cut down, and the lofty will be brought low.

13:4 Listen, a tumult on the mountains as of a great multitude! Listen, an uproar of kingdoms, of nations gathering together! The LORD of hosts is mustering an army for battle.

13:13 Therefore I will make the heavens tremble, and the earth will be shaken out of its place, at the wrath of the LORD of hosts in the day of his fierce anger.

14:22 I will rise up against them, says the LORD of hosts, and will cut off from Babylon name and remnant, offspring and posterity, says the LORD.

14:23 And I will make it a possession of the hedgehog, and pools of water, and I will sweep it with the broom of destruction, says the LORD of hosts.

14:24 The LORD of hosts has sworn: As I have designed, so shall it be; and as I have planned, so shall it come to pass:

14:27 For the LORD of hosts has planned, and who will annul it? His hand is stretched out, and who will turn it back?

17:3 The fortress will disappear from Ephraim, and the kingdom from Damascus; and the remnant of Aram will be like the glory of the children of Israel, says the LORD of hosts.

18:7 [2x]At that time gifts will be brought to the LORD of hosts from a people tall and smooth, from a people feared near and far, a nation mighty and conquering, whose land the rivers divide, to Mount Zion, the place of the name of the LORD of hosts.

19:4 I will deliver the Egyptians into the hand of a hard master; a fierce king will rule over them, says the Sovereign, the LORD of hosts.

19:12 Where now are your sages? Let them tell you and make known what the LORD of hosts has planned against Egypt.

19:16 On that day the Egyptians will be like women, and tremble with fear before the hand that the LORD of hosts raises against them.

19:17 And the land of Judah will become a terror to the Egyptians; everyone to whom it is mentioned will fear because of the plan that the LORD of hosts is planning against them.

19:18 On that day there will be five cities in the land of Egypt that speak the language of Canaan and swear allegiance to the LORD of hosts. One of these will be called the City of the Sun.

19:20 It will be a sign and a witness to the LORD of hosts in the land of Egypt; when they cry to the LORD because of oppressors, he will send them a savior, and will defend and deliver them.

19:25 whom the LORD of hosts has blessed, saying, "Blessed be Egypt my people, and Assyria the work of my hands, and Israel my heritage."

21:10 O my threshed and winnowed one, what I have heard from the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel, I announce to you.

22:5 For the Lord GOD of hosts has a day of tumult and trampling and confusion in the valley of vision, a battering down of walls and a cry for help to the mountains.

22:12 In that day the Lord GOD of hosts called to weeping and mourning, to baldness and putting on sackcloth;

22:14 [2x] The LORD of hosts has revealed himself in my ears: Surely this iniquity will not be forgiven you until you die, says the Lord GOD of hosts.

22:15 Thus says the Lord GOD of hosts: Come, go to this steward, to Shebna, who is master of the household, and say to him:

22:25 On that day, says the LORD of hosts, the peg that was fastened in a secure place will give way; it will be cut down and fall, and the load that was on it will perish, for the LORD has spoken.

23:9 The LORD of hosts has planned it-- to defile the pride of all glory, to shame all the honored of the earth.

24:21 On that day the LORD will punish the host of heaven in heaven, and on earth the kings of the earth.

24:23 Then the moon will be abashed, and the sun ashamed; for the LORD of hosts will reign on Mount Zion and in Jerusalem, and before his elders he will manifest his glory.

25:6 On this mountain the LORD of hosts will make for all peoples a feast of rich food, a feast of well-aged wines, of rich food filled with marrow, of well-aged wines strained clear.

28:5 In that day the LORD of hosts will be a garland of glory, and a diadem of beauty, to the remnant of his people;

28:22 Now therefore do not scoff, or your bonds will be made stronger; for I have heard a decree of destruction from the Lord

GOD of hosts upon the whole land.

28:29 This also comes from the LORD of hosts; he is wonderful in counsel, and excellent in wisdom.

29:6 you will be visited by the LORD of hosts with thunder and earthquake and great noise, with whirlwind and tempest, and the flame of a devouring fire.

31:4 For thus the LORD said to me, As a lion or a young lion growls over its prey, and--when a band of shepherds is called out against it-- is not terrified by their shouting or daunted at their noise, so the LORD of hosts will come down to fight upon Mount Zion and upon its hill.

31:5 Like birds hovering overhead, so the LORD of hosts will protect Jerusalem; he will protect and deliver it, he will spare and rescue it.

37:16 "O LORD of hosts, God of Israel, who are enthroned above the cherubim, you are God, you alone, of all the kingdoms of the earth; you have made heaven and earth.

37:32 for from Jerusalem a remnant shall go out, and from Mount Zion a band of survivors. The zeal of the LORD of hosts will do this.

39:5 Then said to Hezekiah, "Hear the word of the LORD of hosts:

44:6 Thus says the LORD, the King of Israel, and his Redeemer, the LORD of hosts: I am the first and I am the last; besides me there is no god.

45:13 I have aroused Cyrus in righteousness, and I will make all his paths straight; he shall build my city and set my exiles free, not for price or reward, says the LORD of hosts.

47:4 Our Redeemer--the LORD of hosts is his name-- is the Holy One of Israel.

48:2 For they call themselves after the holy city, and lean on the God of Israel; the LORD of hosts is his name.

51:15 For I am the LORD your God, who stirs up the sea so that its waves roar-- the LORD of hosts is his name.

54:5 For your Maker is your husband, the LORD of hosts is his name; the Holy One of Israel is your Redeemer, the God of the whole earth he is called.

כְּבוֹדָ - glory -38x in Isaiah - note that man's glory will fail, only the glory of God endures

3:8 For Jerusalem has stumbled and Judah has fallen, because their speech and their deeds are against the LORD, defying his glorious presence.

4:2 On that day the branch of the LORD shall be beautiful and glorious, and the fruit of the land shall be the pride and glory of the survivors of Israel.

4:5 Then the LORD will create over the whole site of Mount Zion and over its places of assembly a cloud by day and smoke and the shining of a flaming fire by night. Indeed over all the glory there will be a canopy.

5:13 Therefore my people go into exile without knowledge; without glory are dying of hunger, and their multitude is parched with thirst.

6:3 And one called to another and said: "Holy, holy, holy is the LORD of hosts; the whole earth is full of his glory."

8:7 therefore, the Lord is bringing up against it the mighty flood waters of the River, the king of Assyria and all his glory; it will rise above all its channels and overflow all its banks;

10:3 What will you do on the day of punishment, in the calamity that will come from far away? To whom will you flee for help, and where will you leave your glory

10:16 Therefore the Sovereign, the LORD of hosts, will send wasting sickness among his stout warriors, and under his glory a burning will be kindled, like the burning of fire.

10:18 The glory of his forest and his fruitful land the LORD will destroy, both soul and body, and it will be as when an invalid wastes away.

11:10 On that day the root of Jesse shall stand as a signal to the peoples; the nations shall inquire of him, and his dwelling shall be glorious.

14:18 All the kings of the nations lie in glory, each in his own tomb;

16:14 But now the LORD says, In three years, like the years of a hired worker, the glory of Moab will be brought into contempt, in spite of all its great multitude; and those who survive will be very few and feeble.

17:3 The fortress will disappear from Ephraim, and the kingdom from Damascus; and the remnant of Aram will be like the glory of the children of Israel, says the LORD of hosts.

17:4 On that day the glory of Jacob will be brought low, and the fat of his flesh will grow lean.

21:16 For thus the Lord said to me: Within a year, according to the years of a hired worker, all the glory of Kedar will come to an end;

22:18 whirl you round and round, and throw you like a ball into a wide land; there you shall die, and there your chariots of glory shall lie, O you disgrace to your master's house!

22:23 I will fasten him like a peg in a secure place, and he will become a throne of glory to his ancestral house.

22:24 And they will hang on him the whole glory of his ancestral house, the offspring and issue, every small vessel, from the cups to all the flagons.

24:23 Then the moon will be abashed, and the sun ashamed; for the LORD of hosts will reign on Mount Zion and in Jerusalem, and before his elders he will manifest his glory.

35:2 [2x] it shall blossom abundantly, and rejoice with joy and singing. The glory of Lebanon shall be given to it, the majesty of Carmel and Sharon. They shall see the glory of the LORD, the majesty of our God.
