

Notes on Luke 1:26-38

Context

LUKE 1:2 just as they were handed down to us by those who from the first were eyewitnesses and servants of the word. ³Therefore, since I myself have carefully investigated everything from the beginning, it seemed good also to me to write an orderly account for you, most excellent Theophilus, ⁴so that you may know the certainty of the things you have been taught.

Acts 2:18 yea, and on my menservants and my maidservants in those days I will pour out my Spirit; and they shall prophesy.

γένειτό - aorist middle deponent optative 17x in NT -
