χάρις τοῦ θεου - interesting that the "grace of God" is also that thing which leads us to gratitude to God, indeed it seems that without the grace of God it may well be impossible to be truly thankful, for even when an unbeliever is moved in their heart to thanks, who is to say that it was not the grace of God that accomplished it?

It is possible that $\zeta \eta \lambda \omega \tau \eta \zeta$ in Lk 6.15 and $K \alpha \nu \alpha \nu \alpha i \circ \zeta$ in Mt 10.4 function not so much as a designation of an individual belonging to the particular Jewish nationalistic party (according to some scholars such a party may not have been organized at that time), but of one who is simply zealous for national independence. Therefore, one might speak of Simon as Simon the patriot' (the same applies to Ac 1.13, the only other occurrence of $\zeta n\lambda \omega \tau n c$ in the

NT). To render ζηλωτής **b** as `armed insurrectionist' or `guerilla fighter' (as some translators

have suggested) would be reading into the text more than is specifically warranted.
